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Cover photograph – **Hoy's Butchers, Edenderry, Portadown**, The Hoys can be traced back in Seagoe Records as far as the late 17th century and the family has been in the butchery business since the 1800s, originating in the Shambles in the West Street area. In the early years of the 20th century Thomas Hoy great-grandfather of the present owner opened a butcher's shop at Edenderry, in Brights Building, between the Bann Bridge and Foundry Street. Following Thomas Hoy's death, his eldest son John took over the business and Robert and Richard, who also worked in the shop, eventually set up their own butchery businesses. In 1936 the business was moved from the original premises to the present site at 105 Bridge Street, known then as The Modern Meat Supply. The following year, on the death of their father, Johnny and his brother Thomas took over the running of the business, trading as Hoy Brothers until Thomas died in 1983 and Johnny in 1984.
